# Message from OUR PRESIDENT

Since its creation in 2014, Fundación Intellectus has existed to serve the wellbeing of Puerto Ricans. As we enter our tenth year, we take a moment to reflect on our achievements to date and the path we have yet to travel. Originally known as the Ponce Health Science Education Foundation, in its beginnings, Fundación Intellectus served its mission by awarding scholarships to medical students at the Ponce School of Medicine, in honor of our legacy. As a member of the first graduating class of this Institution, my commitment to supporting our future doctors is personal.

Over time, our programs have expanded to focus on three main areas:

- Addressing the shortage of doctors practicing medicine on the island.
- Fostering scientific and health research carried out in Puerto Rico.
- Promoting prevention as a key tool for health and well-being.

During 2023 we were a source of support for 16 medical students from the main medical schools in Puerto Rico, through full and partial scholarships to cover their tuition costs and thus reduce the financial uncertainty that so many young doctors face upon reaching graduation with mountains of debt.

Additionally, we provided support to 7 nonprofit organizations dedicated to improving the physical and mental health of Puerto Ricans through prevention and research.

Finally, we provided scholarships to 29 students and health professionals to conduct, publish and present scientific and medical research with the potential to positively impact the health of Puerto Ricans.

There is no doubt that improving the health of Puerto Ricans is a challenge that we need to address as a country, and that requires the collaboration and coordination of multiple sectors. For our part, at Fundación Intellectus, we are prepared and determined to make our resources available in the pursuit of a healthier Puerto Rico, better prepared and better equipped to care for the health of its citizens.


# Addressing the shortage of DOCTORS


PUERTO RICO ONLY HAS 10,500 DOCTORS TO SERVE A POPULATION OF OVER 3 MILLION PEOPLE. THE SHORTAGE OF DOCTORS IN OUR COUNTRY IS A CHALLENGE THAT NEEDS TO BE MET URGENTLY.



The high costs associated with completing a career in medicine has been identified as one of the main reasons why so many young Puerto Rican doctors choose to practice medicine outside of Puerto Rico.

For this reason, Fundación Intellectus grants two scholarships destined to partially cover the tuition costs of outstanding Puerto Rican medical students who study at one of the Island's four main schools of medicine.


